Through community-driven programs and strategic partnerships, we empower vulnerable children to build resilient futures and lead lives of dignity and hope.

No learner, child or family deserves to get left behind... you and I have the opportunity to influence the change we aspire to see in Africa and her people!

“Breaking Bread” Initiative

Breaking Bread is an **O.R.B.I.T** initiative rooted in dignity, consistency, and shared humanity. It walks side by side with **15 families** over a full year, providing monthly grocery support so that food security becomes one less thing to worry about.

The initiative supports families of impoverished learners at **Hlolisa Primary School in Ekangala**, ensuring that each participating household receives a monthly grocery basket valued at **R1 500.00** for a family of four. Rather than a once-off act of charity, **Breaking Bread** offers steady, reliable support over **12 months**, creating space for families to focus on caring for their children, their education, regaining stability, and rebuilding hope in everyday life.

The assistance is provided quietly and respectfully, without conditions or judgement, because dignity matters as much as provision. At its heart, **Breaking Bread** is about more than groceries - it is about peace of mind, shared responsibility, and the belief that everyone deserves a seat at the table. Through this initiative, **O.R.B.I.T** affirms its commitment to strengthening families and building more resilient communities, together.
